NEW REPORT IDENTIFIES THE 25 MOST CRITICAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS TO SUPPORT NEVADA'S ECONOMIC GROWTH

A new report that identifies the 25 most critical transportation projects to support Nevada's economic growth will be released at a news conference in Las Vegas at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, March 5. The report is being released by [TRIP](http://tripnet.org), a national nonprofit transportation research group based in Washington, DC.

The report, "*Keeping Nevada Connected: Future Mobility in the Silver State*," identifies the 25 most critical transportation projects needed to support Nevada's economic growth. These include projects to build, expand or modernize roads, highways, bridges, mass transit systems and other transportation facilities. TRIP is a national nonprofit transportation research group based in Washington, DC

Will Wilkins, TRIP's executive director, will present the findings of the report at the news conference. Local officials will be on hand to comment on the report.
